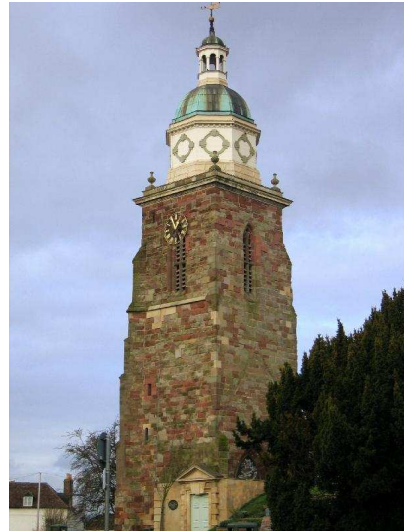


Upton upon Severn Medical Support Trust

The Trust was established in 1988 as a Charity to enable voluntary donations to the Upton Medical Practice to be used as effectively and appropriately as possible. The Trust aims to provide support and equipment to the surgery that cannot be obtained from any other source.

The Trust is managed by a group of local trustees who represent the interests of the local residents and work closely with the Practice. They are selected from the local community so that collectively they have the necessary knowledge and skills to ensure robust operational management of the Trust. No Trustee is connected in any financial or management capacity with the Medical practice.

Recent strategy has been to keep expenditure to a minimum so that funds are available for new equipment and appropriate service developments associated with the new Health Centre. The Trustees are delighted that the project has started and look forward to assisting the surgery to improve local healthcare provision for the residents of Upton and surrounding villages.
